Farm School

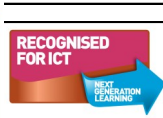
Read, Write, Inc.

Nut Policy

Due to having a pupil in school with a severe nut allergy we have now adopted a 'No Nut Policy' within school. We kindly ask that you do not send your children in with any nut products such as nuts, snickers, peanut butter sandwiches (Nutella is fine). Thank you.

Absences & Medical Evidence

There appears to be some confusion about what is required if we have asked to see medical evidence when your child is absent from school, due to illness and has seen a doctor or dentist.

All that we ask you to provide is an appointment card from the receptionist, we are not asking you to pay for an official medical note. Medicines that have been prescribed and have the chemists label on are also sufficient as evidence. If your child has a hospital appointment, the appointment letter is sufficient as evidence.

If your child is absent for more than 48 hours due to illness, it is your responsibility to call the school office to update us on your child's recovery and when they will be returning to school.
