Why study Sarah Winkler?

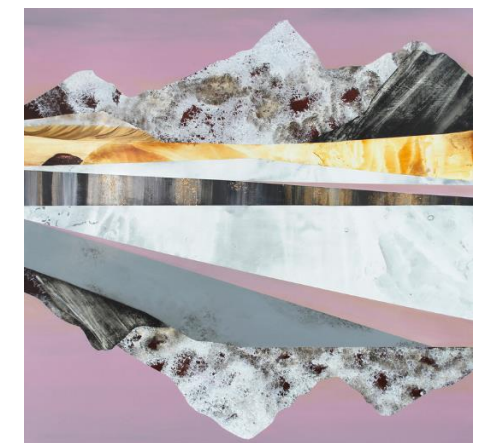
Sarah Winkler's work combines both Art and Earth.

If you look carefully at these pieces of art by Sarah Winkler, you can see the layers she has used. For each layer, she tried to create a different texture. Sarah's work uses bright colours therefore each layer stands out.

Key Vocabulary

Minerals - Sarah uses crushed minerals in her artwork. Minerals include rocks, coal and oils.

Layers- when a sheet or other material covers an area. Sarah layers pieces of art on top of each other.

Texture- the feel, appearance or consistency of a surface.
