Chase View Stick Insect Fact Sheet

We have stick insects ready for rehoming!

Our stick insects require a home that is 3x the body length of the insect in height and 2x the insect in width. The more stick insects you want to keep, the bigger their home needs to be. Stick insects hang upside down to shed their skin and need a high space to hang from. There are plenty of YouTube videos with advice on cheap setups.

Other than their tank or container, care is very simple. Stick insects eat fresh bramble (blackberry). The branches need to be stood in a container of water that should be covered to prevent them from falling in and drowning. We had put holes in the lid of a plastic tub.

The bottom of their home can either be an insect substrate or simply kitchen towel. This is easy to keep clean and makes it very easy to see any eggs.

Once a day, the stick insect enclosure needs misting with water from a spray bottle. This helps to stop them drying out when molting.
