# Governors' Corner Summer 2019

The summer holidays are upon on us and I wanted to update you on Chase View governing board's work throughout this academic year.

- The Read Write Inc (RWI) scheme continues to be strength within our school with phonic results at 96%. RWI is a way of teaching letters and their sounds to children in a fun but systematic and logical manner.
- Bagel breakfast continues to bring the school together every morning, ensuring our children our calm and ready to learn. The impact on attendance is continually positive and has been noted regularly at governors meetings.
- We've had some great results from KS1 that bring us inline with national or above and we will continue to focus on this positive improvement.
- SATS results are improving and we are implementing a new maths program in September.
- Due to new members joining our board, we placed a high priority on understanding Pupil Premium and Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) within our training and had a focused meeting to bring us all up to speed.
