That's a large amount of money isn't it?

This school is currently owed over £3900 by parents for services that have already been provided to their children, and that doesn't include money outstanding for trips.

It could be School Dinners, After School Club, Breakfast Club or Nursery.

Using services or buying goods and not paying, such as eating at a pub or supermarket shopping, and leaving without paying is not something we would do as adults, it is not different just because the money is owed to the school.

While money remains overdue from parents the school has to pay for these services, this means that the way the school runs, and what it can afford to do for the pupils is affected.

The amount outstanding for your child or children may not be a large amount, it may only be a few pounds, but it all adds up.

Some parents settle their ParentPay account in full every week or month, or when they are paid, and this is acceptable.

Others leave amounts to mount up and don't pay the money due.

This cannot go on, and soon the things that we do for the children will have to be cancelled.

We don't want to withdraw services, or stop some pupils using our services, but if we have to, we will.

So, if it is not your normal routine to pay off your ParentPay account on a regular weekly or monthly basis,

- \* please just take a minute to look at your account,
- \* make a payment on ParentPay  
or
- \* bring cash to the office
- \* clear it in full.
