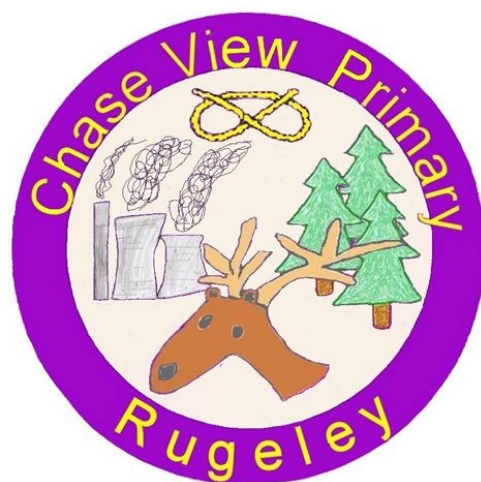

Our catering services are changing, and we are now going to be able to control the menus that you are offered. We can keep some of the old favourites and add new exciting choices.

Only 28% of the whole school usually take a hot dinner,
7% regularly take a school sandwich bag.

We want to know what your children would like to see on our menu that would encourage them to order a school dinner.

The whole of Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes are automatically entitled to Free School Meals.

Some pupils in the rest of the school are also entitled to Free School Meals.
