Helping Young People to 'Bounce Back'

Action for Children are running a two-week workshop which is specifically designed for young people in their transition year from primary to high school. (Year 6-7 or Middle schools Year 8-9)

Bounce Back is a workshop that supports young people to build on their resilience. We understand that transition from primary to high school can be a difficult time. Learning some tips and techniques can help you to gain useful strategies to deal with these changes, supporting young people to bounce back with ease. Empowering young people to tackle negative patterns of thinking and behaviour that may be affecting the way they think and feel.

Bounce Back is a two-session programme with each session lasting 1 hour. A friendly and interactive group with young people who are going through similar experiences.

The sessions will be run online through Teams, and it is important that young people attend both sessions.

Group One - Monday 2nd August 10:00 -11:00am and Monday 9th August 10:00-11:00am

Group Two - Monday 2nd August 4:30-5:30pm and Monday 9th August 4:30-5:30pm

Group Three - Tuesday 17th August 4:30-5:30pm and Tuesday 24th August 4:30-5:30pm
