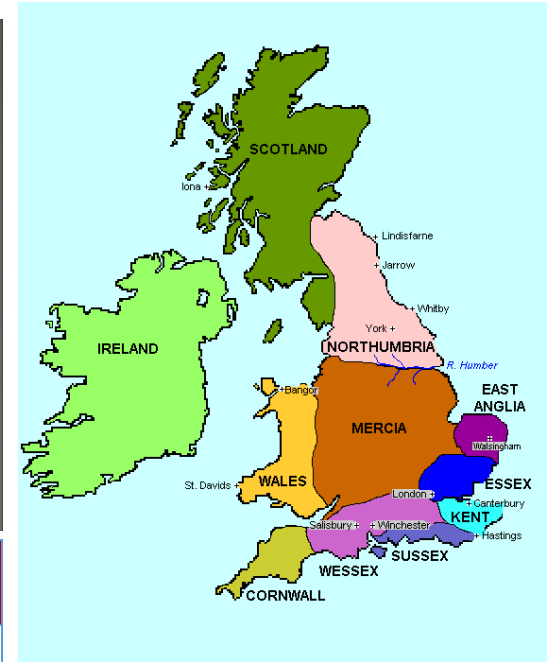


Anglo-Saxons
