Air pollution	Harmful and poisonous substances which are in the air.
Economy	The process or system by which goods and services are produced, sold, and bought in a country.
Economic growth	The increase in the amount of goods and services produced by a country in order to sell them to other countries
Export	When a country sells good to another country
Import	When a country buys goods from another country
Megacity	A very large city with a population over 10 million
Population density	Is a measurement of population per area.
Trade surplus	If a country exports more than it imports
Rural	Characteristics of the countryside
Urban	Characteristics of the town or city



Exported goods	Percentage of total exports
Electrical machinery and equipment	26.3%
Computers	16.3%
Furniture, bedding, lighting, signs	4.2%
Knitted clothing and accessories	3.5%
Non-knitted clothing and accessories	3.4%



Pollution	
Causes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Burning coal for electricity - Factories emit greenhouse gases - Traffic - people are getting richer, so they have more cars - Sewage - 90% of human waste flows into China's rivers 	Impacts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Global warming and climate change - The particles in the air can cause asthma and other respiratory diseases - Water pollution kills fish and makes the water undrinkable for people - Air pollution can cause acid rain and destroy crops
