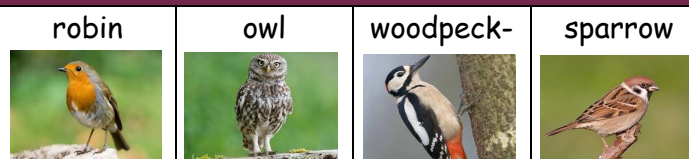

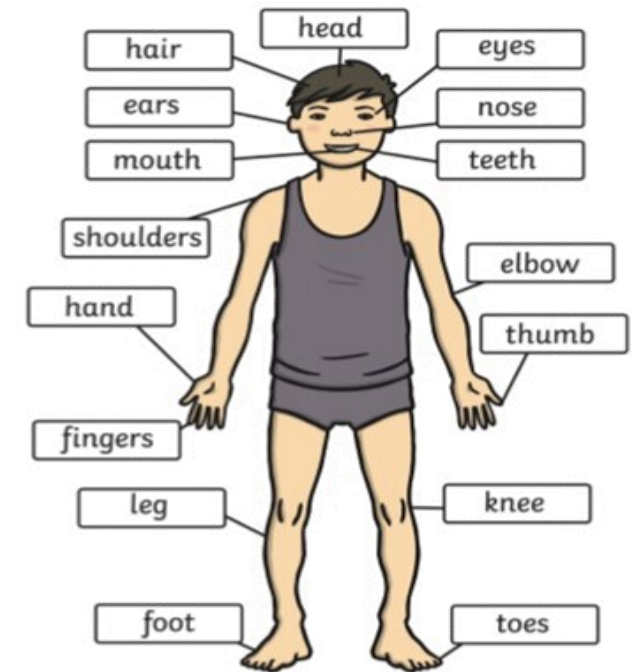
Carnivore, Herbivore or Omnivore
