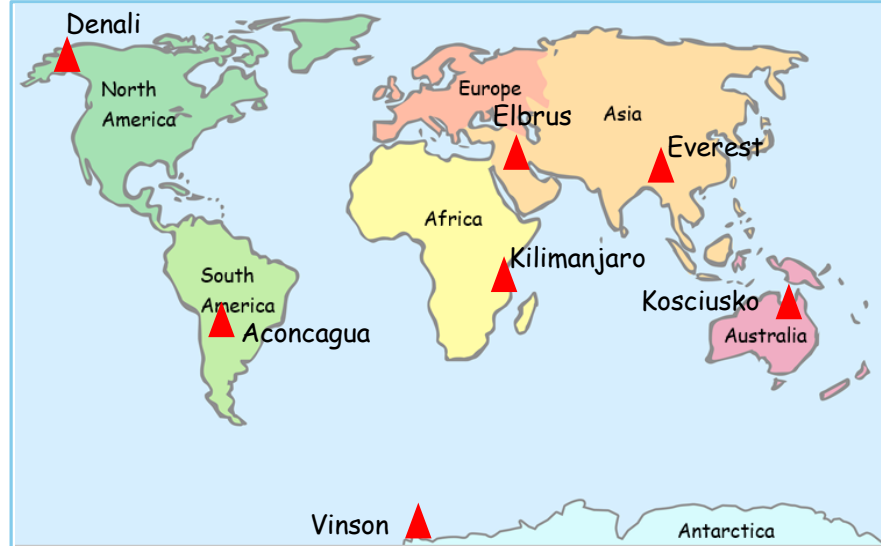
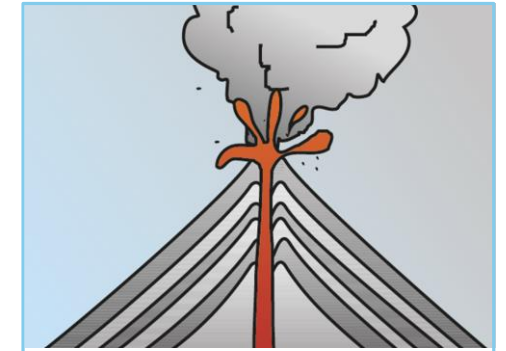


# What is a mountain?

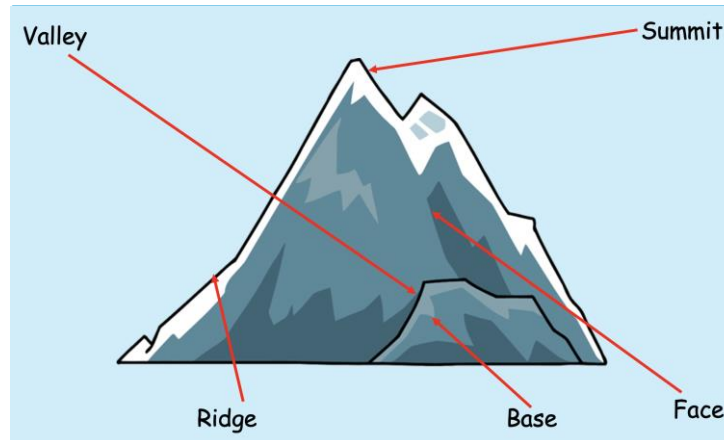
Word	Definition
Base	The bottom of a mountain where it meets flat ground.
Collide	When two things crash together or bump against each other.
Face	The visible side of the mountain.
Fold mountain	A type of mountain created when tectonic plates collide.
Mountain	A part of the land that rises up above everything else.
Mountain range	The collection or group of mountains joined up together.
Ridge	A series of mountains that are connected together to form a long line of mountains.
Summit	The highest point of a mountain or hill.
Tectonic plate	The giant plates that make up the crust of the earth's surface and move about.
Volcanic mountain	A mountain formed around the vents of volcanoes. Made from cooled ash and magma.



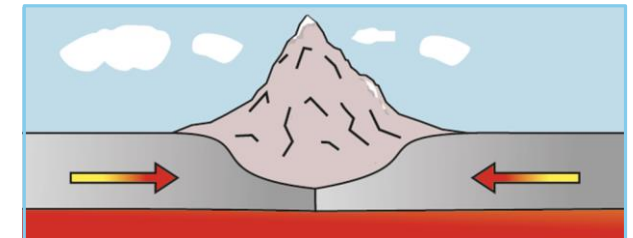
